While using canoes, units will be responsible for paying any damage or loss to canoes, paddles, lifejackets, or trailers that might occur during said unit's use. The camp Ranger/Campmaster and person receiving equipment will check condition before and after use.

**IMPORTANT**

- 1. Trailer may be towed by properly insured truck or car with an adult (over 21) licensed driver.
- 2. Tow vehicle must have a 2" or 1 7/8" ball hitch. (1 7/8" preferred)
- 3. Tow vehicle must be wired for trailer light connections.
- 4. Requestor must have manpower to load and unload canoes at check-out and check-in.
